






Thanksgiving Classroom Activities

- 1. Discussion Activity:
- a. Print & Laminate the category cards (Home, School, Community, Nature, Family) & Things to be thankful for cards
- b. Begin by introducing the idea of being Thankful.

Why do we need to be thankful?

We need to learn to focus on the positive so that we can acknowledge all the good we have in our lives. Being thankful also allows us to think of others and all they do for us and appreciate them.


- c. Place out the first category card and the possible things to be thankful for cards around them.

f. Continue with the different categories until all are done.






