These fun spring Would You Rather Questions will be a great addition to your Spring classroom activities!

What's included in this Would You Rather Questions for Kids?:

There are 3 versions:

1. PowerPoint presentation
2. Printable Black & White
3. Printable Color



Suggested Use:

1. Use the PowerPoint Would You Rather questions during morning group time to get the children talking and sharing ideas.

Encourage your children to extend their answers by giving a reason for their choice.

"I would rather plant vegetable because I can eat them!"

Would You Rather:

Printable (Color & Black & White)

Use as a morning meeting question cards. Place up on the bulletin board.

Use as a classroom pocket chart for students to place their name under the question. Great for signing in or for parents to sign for their child as they enter the classroom for drop off. A great tool for graphing!

Use as a home book on Friday for students to discuss with their parents and bring back on Monday to share.

Use as a home book for your children to color-in their preferences.



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PRINTABLE VERSIONS COLOR + B+W

Use in 6 different ways:

1. Use in morning group time/ morning meeting to get children warmed up and sharing ideas.
2. Make a take home Spring Would You Rather book.
3. Use as a check-in question when children arrive.
4. Use as a way for parents and children to connect at drop off in the morning.
5. Use as a tool to introduce graphing.
6. Connect with families – send one home on Fridays for the children to discuss with their families and come back to class on Monday to report what their different family members said.
