6. Half page pictures without questions prompts.



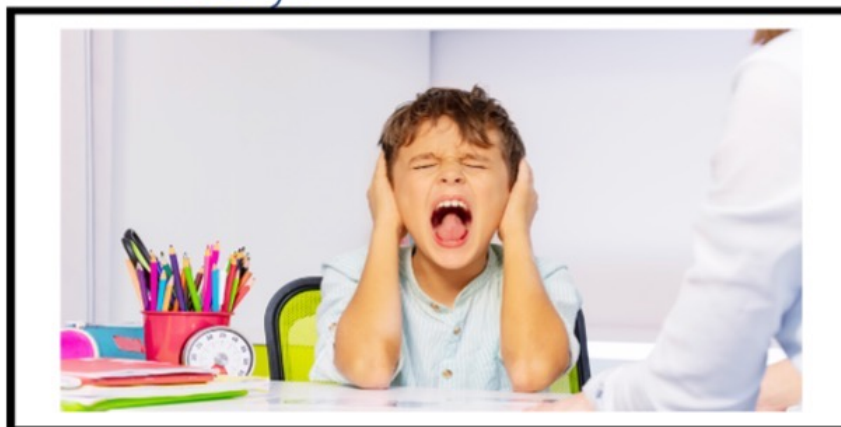

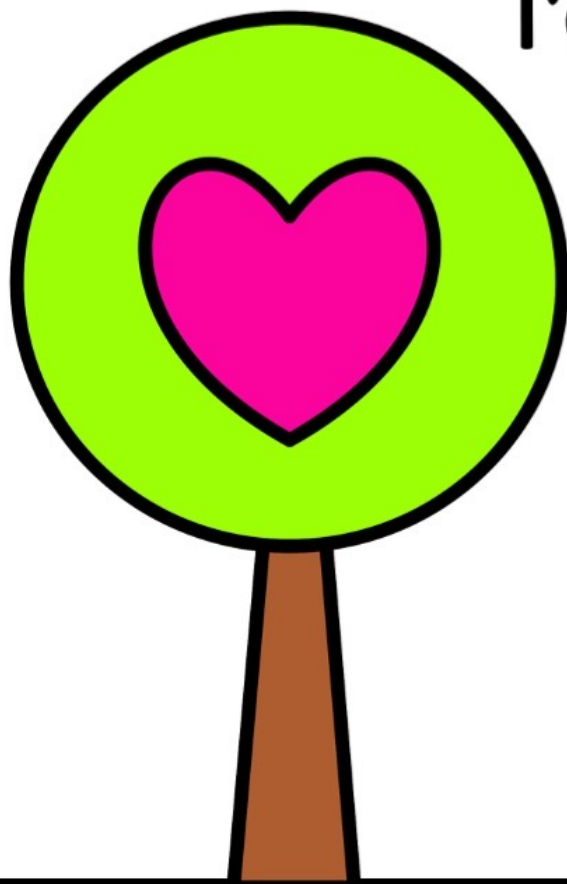
